Target Group

TANF-eligible individuals who need a reliable vehicle to get to work:

- ◆ Whose household income does not exceed 200% of the Federal Poverty Level

and

- ◆ Who are parents, expectant parents, non-custodial parents, or custodial relatives of a minor child

Program Criteria

- ◆ Working for at least 30 days
- ◆ Working 30 or more hours a week
- ◆ Have a valid driver license without suspensions or revocations
- ◆ Need a vehicle for transportation to employment

Vehicle Purchase

- ◆ Participant will search for a vehicle and purchase from a New York State certified auto dealer
- ◆ Vehicles will need lemon law coverage or an equal warranty

Participant Responsibilities

- ◆ Complete a vehicle maintenance class
- ◆ Complete a safe driving class
- ◆ Complete budget counseling with a loan counselor
- ◆ Maintain full insurance coverage (comprehensive, collision, and liability) on the vehicle
